This is an Easy Read version of some information. It may not include all of the information but it will tell you about the important parts.




This Easy Read booklet uses easier words and pictures. Some people may still want help to read it.

What is care and support?



Some people need care and support to live independently.

This might be because of a disability or a health condition.

Care and support can include help with:

• Getting in and out of bed, washing and getting dressed.



• Going to work, making food, eating and spending time with others.



• Dealing with stress or worries.



If you need care and support



If you are finding it hard to look after yourself at home, or going out is difficult for you, we can help.



The City of London Adult Social Care Team can talk to you about what you need.



We will talk about what is important to you and decide on the best way to help you. This is called an **assessment**.



We will think about your health and what is important to you and your family.



This is so you can stay healthy and look after yourself for as long as you can.

Who can get care and support?



If you are finding things difficult without support, we will give you an assessment.



If we decide that you need help from us, we will give you the care and support that is right for you.



If we decide that you do not need care and support from us, we will tell you about other services that might be able to help you.

Will I have to pay for my care and support?



If you get care and support from us, you might need to pay some money towards its cost.



We will work out how much money you need to pay by asking you about your savings and **income**.



Income is how much money you get each month, like from a job.




This will help us know if you can afford to help pay towards your care and support.
