May The City of London 2040 consultation continue to inspire financial centres in many parts of the world. I found it difficult to respond to the questions on City Plan 2040 – Regulation 19 consultation however may I please suggest some ideas for potential use should you find them useful in the process of consultation:

Ring roads 1,2,3,4 for City of London Square Mile to enhance the traffic.

Introduce cruises with start journeys from City of London Roman and UNESCO historical sites St Paul's and Tower of London to New York Frankfurt Paris and other financial capitals to Rome Pompei Gibraltar Istanbul Butrint and other heritage destinations in the Mediterranean and around the world.

Introduce Horse and Cart transport (with modern electric battery) where roads are narrow in the City of London as part of City of London Transport for London.

Introduce Newly designed brands: City of London Cars City of London Motorcycles City of London Bicycles City of London Trainers City of London Shoes.

Introduce a New Electric Tram in the City of London with reall green grass between the rail tracks and platforms going over one or two bridges and to different parts of London and double the greenery.

Repaint iconic strategic logos and parts of the City of London in original colours and Gold.

Recruit a Team of Architects and Officials and other of different generations who Love the City of London its function and history who are prepared to constantly walk and work around and for the Love of the City of London to double check views and visions of the City of London from North, West, East, South, Sky and River Thames in London. A kind of walk that requires permanent dedication to the City of London as a financial resource network established business land of everyday of everyone for different and for many generations.

The above Team of Architects and Officials and other could be allowed to replicate the Square Mile of City of London elsewhere and make it another success story to last for more than 2000 years. The Team should design new architectural works from within the historical buildings work from within the historical context and should not be allowed to rebuilt buildings above St Paul's or the Tower of London as is has happened with beautiful Guildhall being built on top of the Roman Amphitheatre. The above Team could be allowed to build further away under external parts where it would be possible for the noise of transport not to be heard above on the floor level like it is heard in many of the churches where people cannot pray in peace or be heard while the underground train passes under or cannot be heard in some of the shops and restaurants when talking to sales assistants or making an order or have a conversation during a meal.

The first four floors of Newly Built Buildings around the City of London could be designed to be open and to belong to the public needs. The investors/landlords of those Newly Built Buildings who own the land should be flexible and allow a non-restrictive lease for up to 100 years to benefit the City of London and its people to widen the roads expand and develop convenient transportation and enterprises that are needed to meet every challenge of every age that the City of London needs to stay and be the relevant world and a global British success story. The City of London could allow necessary rewards where possible for the investors of the Newly Built Buildings to build four floors above at the top to re-compensate for the four floors at the bottom.

Where buildings are very old the sites must be protected and if roads cannot be widened introduce the transport the City of London had from the time when they were built including horse and cart

(with modern on electric battery) to protect the foundations and the character of the buildings history and the history of the City of London.

Some of the cluster buildings do not look and work in harmony together. If we were able to change places of some of the buildings' views would be so much better. Many buildings are stand-alone buildings not so good for the eye and combining materials and floor levels next to each other do not match. Some of those buildings allow and some do not allow remodelling at the top to be connected with a bridge cycling route or cable cars to ease transport at the street level. But newly built buildings could be designed where the top of the buildings is used for transportation. Good to have offices at the top and to add and connect new buildings with retail food entertainment leisure and shopping areas would be another attraction at the top of the buildings and reduce isolation.

City of London must have connection with High Speed rail and national and international airports with all parts of UK EU and the world within minutes and with precise timetable.

City of London must have its own City of London Monthly and Seasons Calendar packed with variety of activities every day of the week throughout the year to attract people to come to the City of London. Some ideas to be digested amongst many thousands are:
