LAMAS welcome the City of London Local Plan 2040, but regret that it has no direct statement to say that the City of London are fully committed to the protection and safeguarding of the City of London's listed buildings and conservation areas. Local Plan 2015 - Policy DM 12.2 - Development in Conservation Areas, and policy DM 12.3 - Listed Buildings have both been deleted from the 2040 Local Plan, diminishing the emphasis on the protection of these irreplaceable assets and spaces.

The 2015 plan - Core Strategic Policy CS12: Historic Environment identifies the need to:

- 1. Safeguard the City's listed buildings and their settings, while allowing appropriate adaptation and new uses.
- 2. Preserving and enhancing the distinctive character and appearance of the City's conservation areas, while allowing sympathetic development within them

There is no similar stated aim within the 2040 plan to safeguard listed buildings and conservation areas.

Local Plan 2015 Core Strategic Policy CS14: Tall Buildings para 2 states that 'planning permission for tall buildings will be refused within inappropriate areas, comprising: conservation areas'. There is no equivalent aim stated in the 2040 plan. The City of London has a duty to protect conservation areas, which should continue to include the refusal of planning permission for tall buildings in these areas.
