My response to the City Plan relates to Chapter 3 – Health, Inclusion and Safety. At least I think it does as I haven't commented on a local plan. If this isn't the right section, then please forgive me. I want to focus mainly on the inclusion part for this representation. For the City to be more inclusive it's design should be authored by as diverse a group as possible. Employment and training initiatives that allow S106 contributions to be spent in a way that focusses on non-construction roles in the built environment would in my opinion support an objective of the City Plan. i.e. for it to be more inclusive.
