"The reference in OS3 (5) Biodiversity to "Wildlife-friendly features, such as nesting or roosting boxes" is welcome but it's not sound as not effective nor compliant with national policy as swift bricks, a universal nest brick for small bird species, are the only type of nest box referenced in national planning guidance (NPPG 2019 Natural Environment paragraph 023), and also London Plan G6 B4 specifically refers to artificial nest sites appropriate for the urban environment, i.e. swift bricks."
