Bevis Marks specifically is not adequately protected by HE1(8), which extends protection to its "immediate setting" which is not a recognised term and obfuscates the extent of protection it should be given as a Grade I listed building, component of the Creechurch Conservation area, and site of superlative importance to English Jewry.
