The City of London (One Way Streets) (Old Jewry) (No.8) Experimental Order 2024



Coming into operation: 5th July 2024

The Common Council of the City of London, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the City of London, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and section 8 of, and Part I of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The City of London (Old Jewry) (No.8) Experimental Order 2024 and shall come into operation on 5th July 2024.
2. In this Order, “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument, having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by of any subsequent enactment.
3. Whilst this Order remains in force, without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of London (One Way Streets) (No.1) Traffic Order 2015(c) shall have effect as though the provisions of that Order shall apply to the item numbered 1 and set out in the Schedule to this Order as if that item was in Schedule 3 to that Order.
4. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Director, City Operations, or some person authorised in that behalf by them, may, if it appears to them or that person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or of preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this order runs, and after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the City of London, modify or suspend this Order or any provision thereof.

1 Street of length of street	2 Direction
1. Old Jewry	from north to south

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order, in the City of London, introduces, on an experimental basis, a one-way traffic restriction in Old Jewry from north to south except pedal cycles, for its entire length.

Under section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the provisions of this Order may be modified or suspended.
