The City of London (One Way Streets) (Amendment No. *) Order 2024

The Common Council of the City of London, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the City of London, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and section 8 of, and Part I of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985(b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as The City of London (One Way Streets) (Amendment No. *) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on ********.
- 2. In this Order, "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument, having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, reenacted by, or as having effect by, any subsequent enactment.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of London (One Way Streets) Traffic Order 2015(**c**) shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) for the item in Schedule 1 to that Order numbered 2 there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) the items numbered 34, 36, 47 and set out in Schedule 1 to that Order are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order further amends The City of London (One Way Streets) Traffic Order 2015, in the City of London in:-

- (a) **Angel Street** to reverse the direction of the existing one way restriction from west to east, to east to west;
- (b) **Montague Street** to revoke the existing one way restriction;
- (c) Newgate Street to revoke the existing one way restrictions;
- (d) St Martin's Le Grand to revoke the existing one way restriction.
